BYLAW NO. 2024-07

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH LICENCE FEES FOR MINING CONTRACTORS AND WELL DRILLING **CONTRACTORS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in accordance with Subsection 9 (1) (a) and (b), of *The Municipalities Act, 2006,* enacts as follows:

The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish licence fees for Mining Contractors and Well Drilling Contractors within the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64.

DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw:

- 1. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64
- 2. "Contractor" shall mean any person, firm or corporation

SHORT NAME

This Bylaw may be referred to as the "Drilling Fees Bylaw."

- 1. Every mining and well drilling contractor, prior to beginning any drilling in the Municipality, shall pay to the Municipality the following licence fee:
 - a) For the drilling of a horizontal oil well, vertical oil well or each subsequent leg, or a gas well:

\$450.00 (Four Hundred and Fifty) dollars.

- b) For the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information: \$250.00 (Two Hundred and Fifty) dollars.
- 2. Any contractor holding a licence under this Bylaw shall produce and exhibit their licence when required to do so by the Municipality, police officer, or other authorized person.

Bylaw No. 2000-86 is hereby repealed.

COMING INTO FORCE

This bylaw shall come into force upon the third and final reading.
